**(For attention of all candidates who have applied for appointment as
TGTs/JBTs against the posts advertised by SSA Society, UT, Chandigarh
with last date as 13th August, 2009)**

All the candidates who have applied for appointment against the posts TGTs/JBTs in response to advertisement issued by Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Society, UT, Chandigarh are hereby informed that the following revised selection criteria shall be applied for the selection against the above mentioned advertised posts:

1. The candidates shall be required to fulfill the minimum educational as well as the professional qualifications and the age limits as laid down in the advertisement dated 14.7.2009.
2. The candidates shall be required to appear in a competitive objective type test to be held for the post applied for. Other information regarding test is as under:
Duration of the Test- 2.30 hours; No. of objective (multi choice) Questions-150;
Marks per question- 1 mark; Breakup of marks - Subject Based: 100 marks;
General Knowledge/Awareness: 20 marks; Mental Ability/I.Q.: 10 marks; Teaching Ability: 10 marks; General English: 10 marks; Total: 150 marks; Difficulty level: BA/BSc; Qualifying marks: 40%; and there would be no negative marking.

Selection of candidates shall depend purely upon the merit in the competitive objective type test as mentioned above, however, candidates double the number of posts subject to a minimum of 10 and in order of merit, shall be asked to get their original testimonials checked by a committee to be constituted for the purpose and the merit as determined by the test shall prevail subject to the testimonials of the candidate found in order.

As per clarification issued by Chandigarh Administration, Scheduled Castes from all over India would be eligible for benefit of reservation on the pattern of the Central Government. For OBCs, the benefit of reservation to this category would be extended only to those castes which are included in both in the Central List and the Union Territory, Chandigarh list. Accordingly the names of those candidates, who have applied under SC or OBC category and (i) who have not sent the requisite caste certificates in response to letters sent to them; (ii) whose caste certificates are not in order; and (iii) whose caste does not fall both in the Central and Chandigarh list, have been included in General category subject to their fulfillment of qualifications and age limits as required for General category. The names of candidates whose caste is included in both the central and Chandigarh lists have been kept in OBC category and letters have been written to them for production of certificate in accordance with Govt. of India, Ministry of Social Welfare Resolution No. 12011/68/93-BCC(C) dated 10.9.1993. They will be considered in OBC category only in case they produce the valid OBC certificate with reference of Resolution dated 10.9.1993 failing which they would be considered as general candidate subject to their fulfillment of qualifications and age limits as required for General category.

The candidates of general category, who have applied for the post where no post was advertised for general category, have been included in the 'Not Eligible' list, however, candidates of other categories where no post has been advertised have been converted into general category subject to their fulfillment of qualifications and age limits as required for General category.

The candidates for the posts of TGT Hindi, Punjabi & English who have not passed the concerned elective subject at graduation level but have passed the concerned subject at post graduation level have been declared eligible.

The candidates are hereby informed that the lists of candidates found 'NOT ELIGIBLE' alongwith the reason thereof; and of candidates found 'ELIGIBLE PROVISIONALLY SUBJECT TO FINAL CHECKING OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS' have been published on the official website of the society i.e. www.ssachd.nic.in Candidates may peruse the said lists for their information.

The competitive objective type test for the above posts shall tentatively be held in the month of August, 2010 about which the candidates found provisionally eligible shall be informed individually.
